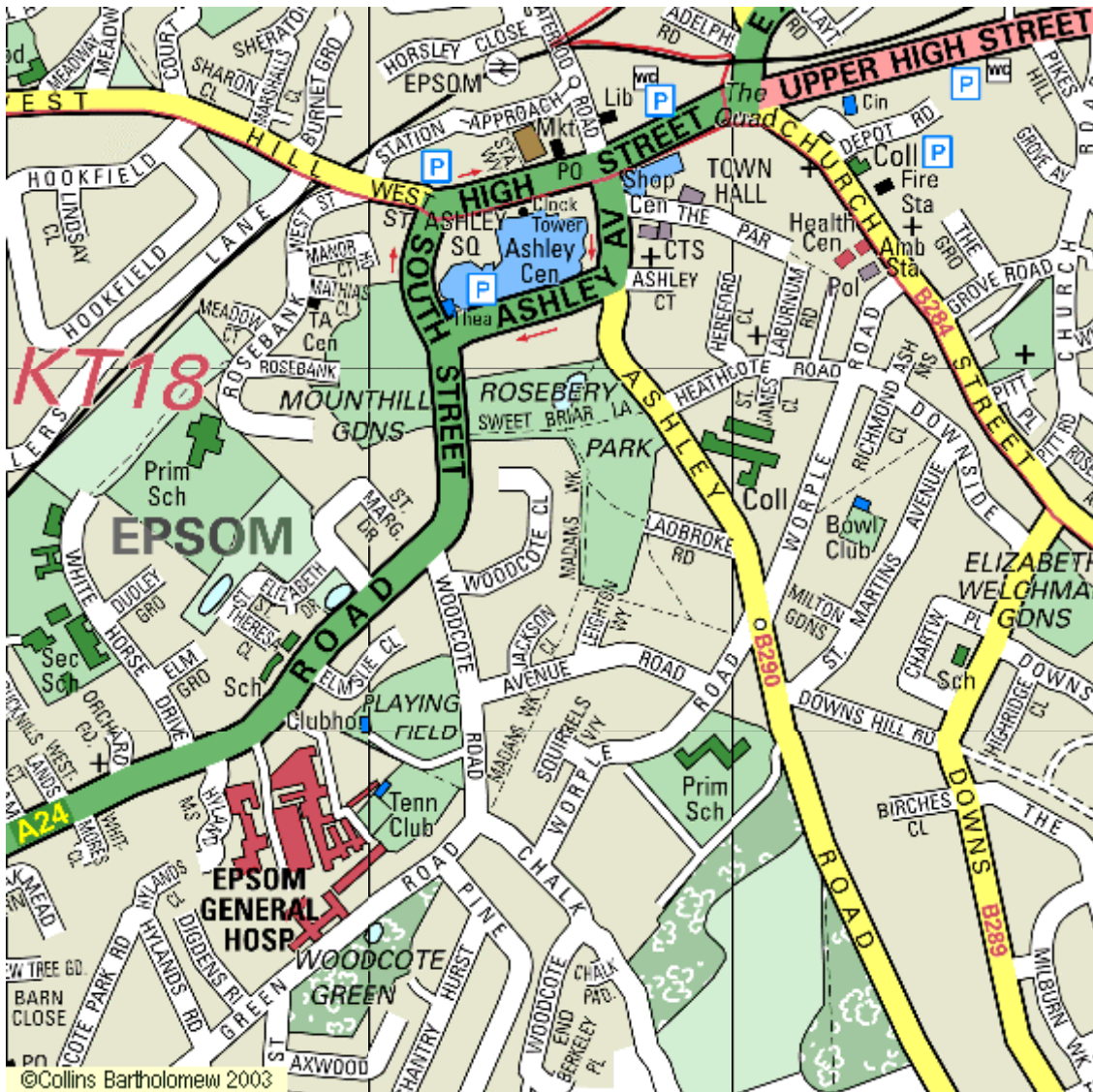


ACB Southern Region – Summer Meeting

Getting to Epsom General Hospital

Travelling by Bus

The following bus routes serve Epsom General Hospital:

- E5 - Langley Vale/The Wells - Epsom - Watersedge (Every 30 minutes, with alternate departures from Langley Vale and the Wells Estate)
- K10 - Langley Vale - Epsom – Kingston (Every hour)
- 166 - EpsomGeneralHospital - Epsom - Banstead - West Croydon (Every 20 minutes)
- 293 - EpsomGeneralHospital - Epsom - North Cheam – Morden (Every 20 minutes)
- 408 - Epsom - Ashted - Leatherhead – Cobham (Limited number of services per day).
- 479 - Epsom - Ashted - Leatherhead – Guildford (Every 30 minutes peak)

Travelling by Rail

There are direct services to Epsom Station from London Waterloo, London Victoria, Sutton, Cheam, Ewell East, Stoneleigh, West Croydon, Bookham, Dorking, Leatherhead and Effingham Junction.

Epsom Hospital is then a 20 minute walk or a short taxi or bus ride from the station.

Travelling by Car

A24 (Sutton) from London

A24 (North) from M25 Junction 9, Leatherhead and Dorking

A240 from Kingston and A3 from London

A232 from Croydon and Sutton

Car Parking

Note Parking spaces are limited.

Car parking is operated as a 'pay on foot' system. The charges are £2.00 for the first hour followed by a £1 charge for each 30 minutes thereafter, up to a maximum charge of £12.00 per day.

Motorcycle Parking

The Trust has provided a new dedicated motorcycle parking area outside the Arrivals and Departures Unit (Woodcote Green Road entrance). The area provides locking posts. There is no charge for motorcycle parking.

Cycling

A sheltered area for parking bicycles is now located near the main entrance to the Derby Suite, opposite the visitor car park (Dorking Road entrance).

Further bicycle parking stands can be found outside the main entrance to the South West London Elective Orthopaedic Centre, Denbies Wing (Woodcote Green Road entrance).
